Submission of Manuscripts: Submit two copies of manuscript to the Editor, Personality Study & Group Behaviour, Department of Psychology, Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar-43005 (India). Submit CD in page maker system of type setting along with hard copy of manuscript. Empirical research papers, theoretical papers, review articles and book review can be submitted.

MANUSCRIPT PREPARATION

Manuscript should be as short and succinct as possible; 20 double spaced page are ordinarily maximum although it is realised that some papers may exceed this limit. Figures should be included only if it is absolutely necessary. References should be carefully chosen, and only those that are relevant to the reported research should be given.

Manuscripts should be typed in double spacing with wide margins and only on one side of each sheet. All articles should include an abstract of 100-175 word. Tables and foot-notes should be given on separate sheets. The place of their inclusion in the text must be indicated.

Tables should be typed in double spacing. Each should have a self-explanatory title and should be comprehensive without reference to the text. Data given should be checked for accuracy and must agree with mentions in the text.

Figures i.e. diagrams, graphs or other illustrations, should be on separate sheets, numbered sequentially ' Fig, I etc. and each identified on the back with the author name and title of the paper. They should be carefully drawn, larger than their intended size, Suitable for photographic reproduction and clear when reduced in size.

Bibliographical references in the text should be listed alphabetically by author at the end of the article, according to the format:

Cattell, R.B. The scree test for the number of factors. *Multivariate Behaviour Research*, 1966. 1-245-276.

Piaget, J. *The origins of Intelligence in children*, New York: Norton 1963.

Particular care should be taken to ensure that references are accurate and complete.
